

January 2007 Weather Summary

Report based on Dawson Creek Airport Data

January 2007 saw a great start to the year with the temperature well above normal for the month. The average temperature reached -6.1 for the month 8.6 degrees above the normal of -14.7. The 24th saw a new daily high temperature record set with 11.3 degrees recorded breaking the old record of 11.2 set last year.

Temperatures

- Average daily high of 0.1 was above the normal of -8.7 degrees C.
- Average daily low of -12.2 was above the normal of -20.6 degrees C.
- Mean temperature of -6.1 was above the normal of -14.7 degrees C.
- Monthly high temperature 11.3 degrees Celsius on the 24th
- Monthly low temperature -33.9 degrees Celsius on the 11th.

- New daily maximum 11.3 on the 24th. Previous 11.2/2006
